



June 2026 Debt/Bank Loan for Worship Center, Music Center and Kid City

First Baptist Church of Tempe Church Action Meeting – April 14, 2024 Results

The congregation of First Baptist Church of Tempe has elected Pastor John Heston as our full-time Senior Pastor with a 97% positive vote.

Pastor Heston is a seasoned Pastor with over 25 years of experience of increasing responsibility in church leadership. He is committed to shepherding individuals to Christ, engaging the community in local and global outreach, and has a strong focus on discipleship. John will be transitioning from his current position to full-time ministry at FBCT over the next couple of months.

Charitable Donations from IRA's

If you are over 70 ½ and have assets held in an Individual Retirement Account (IRA), you can transfer a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from the IRA directly to a charity taxfree. Normally, distributions from a traditional IRA are taxable when received. With a QCD, however, these distributions become tax-free as long as they're paid directly from the IRA to an eligible charitable organization. Also, a QCD equal or greater than your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), when you reach the age these are required, will satisfy that requirement. As with any financial subject, the government could change the rules, so it is always best to check with your accountant or tax advisor before proceeding.

RETIREMENT

How much can I transfer from my IRA to charity? Can I transfer more than my RMD?

Yes, if you are 70½ or older, you can transfer up to \$100,000 to charity tax-free each year -- even if that's more than your RMD. The money counts as your RMD but isn't included in your adjusted gross income.

I'll be 70½ in a few months. Can I give my RMD to charity now? No--you have to wait until you are at least one day over 70½ years of age to make the tax-free transfer to charity.

Can I give do this with my 401(k) funds as well?

No. You can <u>only</u> make the tax-free transfer from an IRA. Therefore, you cannot make such a tax-free distribution from a 401(k), 401(b), 401(a), or any other ERISA account.

Can I withdraw the money from my IRA and then write a check to charity, or do I need to transfer the money directly?

The rules are very strict in this regard. You must have the custodian of your IRA transfer the money <u>directly from</u> your IRA <u>to the non-profit</u> for it to count as the tax-free transfer.

Each custodian has slightly different procedures on how they do this but the funds must go directly out of the IRA and directly to the charity.

It is <u>extremely important</u> that you notify the non-profit that you are donating to them so that they will know 'who' the donor is! It also helps to provide the non-profit's ID number, exact mailing address, phone number, and a person that the mail is to be directed to. For example, in the case of a donation to First Baptist Church of Tempe, you would tell the custodian of your IRA the following information:

If you have check-writing privileges for your IRA, you can write a check to the charity but be sure to alert the charity so it knows the contribution came from you!

So which is better: the tax-free transfer or the charitable deduction?

If you do not itemize, then the tax-free transfer is nearly always more advantageous to the donor. Just remember to alert your tax preparer as the custodian of your IRA will still issue a <u>1099R</u>. You need to show the tax preparer the <u>donation-letter</u> you received from the non-profit to prove that the charity received the funds.


