## **Missionary Updates**

**Jim Fasold:** Summer camps ended the last week of August. Your prayers and support accomplished far more than we could have imagined! Over 1,000 campers enjoyed the new teepees this summer. They came from all over Spain and were especially challenged by this year's theme: "Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us" (Heb. 12:1).

• Of the 1,000 campers, 166 declared they were Christians.

- 114 said they were interested in God but have not yet accepted Christ as their Savior.
- However, 27 accepted Christ as their Savior!
- 10 of these campers were encouraged to join a discipleship group.
- Various campers asked to receive a free copy of the Bible.

At the same time, 86 campers said they do not believe in God, a reflection of the fact that less than 1% of Spain's 47 million citizens are Christians. The programs and banners set up around the camp this summer had as their theme "Roman Times". Because the campers have so much fun with themes such as this one

along with the camp's exceptional installations, they become the best promoters of the camp. For example, last year 40 young people from a basketball club spent a weekend at the camp after the summer camps had ended. They had so much fun that they talked the whole club – 120 young people! – into coming this year to a weekend retreat. In addition, these weekends with non-Christian groups allow our staff to share with their leaders what L'Arcada is all about... because they ask! Once again, thank you for your prayers and support.
