Use the "OPA Bible Study Method."

Read Mark 12:41-44

The OPA Bible Study Method

Step 1: Observations

Compile all the facts found in the passage.

Step 2: Principles

 Draw a few principles from the observations you have made. What is God trying to teach you in this passage?

Step 3: Application

 How will you apply these principles to your life? Be specific. A good application will have a who, what, and when to it.

Paul taught generosity when he wrote to Timothy.

Use the "Five P Bible Study Method" to dive into the passage.

Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19

The Five P Bible Study Method

Step 1: Purpose – ask yourself these questions:

- What do you think the author wrote this for?
- Why is it important enough to be in the Bible?

Step 2: Primary Verse

- Which verse seems to contain the most important thought in the passage?
- Which one stands out most to you?

Step 3: Promises

 Make a list of any promises you find. Sometimes you will need to infer a promise from a passage.

Step 4: Problems -

 Ask yourself if there is anything that you couldn't explain to a friend. Ask someone for the answer or look it up for yourself.

Step 5: Practical Application - be specific, realistic

- What action should you take?
- What do you need to work on so that what you have read is real in your life?
